ATTIRE AND EQUIPMENT

All riders, including those not competing, **MUST** wear ASTM certified protective headgear while mounted on a horse or pony anywhere on the show grounds. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** All Riders participating in the show are required to wear: (1) properly secured ASTM certified protective headgear and (2) hard-soled riding boots with a heel. Half chaps are permitted, **NO** full chaps. Riders are encouraged to show in proper attire.

Class Specifications/Rules

Warm-Up: Open to all riders on horse or pony. Class is open all day at height of division

Lead Line: Open to all

Walk/Trot Eq: For the beginner rider. Riders may not cross enter into any other classes at the same show and may never have shown over fences exceeding 18". Points are awarded to the rider. Fences shall be rails on the ground. All rails must be placed between standards that have no attached jump cups.

Crossrail Eq: For the beginning rider. Points are awarded to the rider. Riders may not cross enter into any classes that exceed 18" at the same show. Fences 12" in a "X" rail configuration.

Future Eq: For the beginning rider. Points are awarded to the rider. Riders may not cross enter into any class where fences exceed 2'0" at the same show. Fences 18", no oxers.

Stirrup Hunter: Open to beginner riders. Riders may not cross enter into classes where fences exceed 2'3" at the same show. Fences 2'0", no oxers.

Pre Children's/Adult Amateur Division: Riders may not cross enter into classes where fences exceed 2'6" at the same show. Fences 2'3", no combinations.

Children's/Adult Amateur Division: Riders may not cross enter into classes where fences exceed 2'9" at the same show. Fences 2'6", no combinations.

Junior/Adult Amateur Division: Open to junior and adult amateur riders. Fences 2'9".

Schooling Hunter: Open to all. Horse may not compete in classes over fences above 3'0" at the same show. Fences 2'6".

Open Hunter Division: Open to all. Fences 3'0".

Open Equitation Division: Open to juniors and adult amateur riders. Fences 3'0"

THJA Mini Medal: Open to all junior and adult amateur members of THJA who are not showing over fences above 2'9" at the same show. To be shown over an equitation type course of not less than eight fences at 2'6" in height, including at least two changes of direction. No combinations. At least the top 2 riders will return for further testing (USEF Tests 1-8). Two entries are required to fill the class.

THJA Children's/Adult Amateur Medal: Open to all junior and adult amateur members of THJA. To be shown over an equitation type course of not less than eight fences at 3'in height, including at least two changes of direction and one combination. After the over fences phase, the top six riders (if available) will return for a group flat phase. Martingales are permitted for the over fences phase only – no martingales in the flat phase. Scores from each phase shall count equally. At the judge's discretion, at least the top two riders will return for further testing (USEF Tests 1-8). Two entries are required to fill the class.

THJA Flat Medal: Open to all junior and adult amateur members of THJA. Entries will work collectively on the flat and will be asked to demonstrate at least two advanced flat work skills such as turn on the forehand, turn on the haunches, counter canter, leg yields, lengthening and/or collection of the stride, work without irons, and/or other tests deemed appropriate by the judge. Two entries are required to fill the class.

AHJA CAT II Child/Adult Medal: Open to all junior and adult amateur members of AHJA. Work off at judge's discretion. 4 riders must complete course for class to count Fences 2'3"

AHJA CAT I Child/Adult Medal: Open to junior riders who have not competed over

fences higher than 3'3" (Hunters and Equitation) or 1.0 meter (jumpers) during the current show year at USEF Regular Member Horse Shows. The course must include one combination, two changes of direction, a single oxer and a minimum of 8 fences. Two or more tests are required of the top 4 competitors. USEF Tests 1-17. Fence 3'0".

ADAPTIVE CLASSES: Open to any junior or adult rider with a physical, cognitive, sensory or emotional disability. Riders must be in english tack but may use adaptive tack such as grip or balance reins or basket stirrups

Adaptive Walk: Riders to show at walk, halt and two-point position. Riders may be independent or have volunteer assistance, including a leader and/or sidewalkers. Riders will be judged on equitation and execution of skills

Adaptive Walk/Trot: Same as above but riders will show a posting or sitting trot one at a time down the length of the long side only.

JUMPER CLASSES: Unless otherwise specified, USEF rules will apply. Classes will be run over a course of eight to ten jumper type fences. Classes are open to all riders on any horse or pony.

2' Jumper Division: Fences .65m (2'0), spreads to .70m (2'3") Always run as Optimum Time

Low Jumper Division: Fences .75 meters (.2'6"), spreads to .85 meters (2'9").

Medium Jumper Division: Fences .85 meters (2'9"), spreads to .95 meters (3'1").

High Jumper Division: Fences .95 meters (3'1"), spreads to 1.10 meters (3'7").

Level 2 Jumper Division: Fences 1.00 meter (3'3"), spreads to 1.15 meters (3'9").

Level 3 Jumper Division: Fences 1.10 meters (3'7"), spreads to 1.25 meters (4'1).

Gambler's Choice: To be shown over a course of 9 obstacles at 2'6"-2'9" in height. Each obstacle will have a point value depending on degree of difficulty. Each rider will have 60 seconds to accumulate as many points as possible. Each obstacle may be jumped twice only if there are no faults at the first attempt. After crossing finish line each rider will have the option of attempting the joker fence set at 3". The rider will have 30 seconds to complete the joker fence valued at 200 points. Time will decide the winner in the event of a tie. Ribbon through 6th place. \$150, \$120, \$80, \$60, \$50, \$40

Schooling: Rings available for schooling on Friday, April 9. Please call ahead if you intend to school on Friday. Ring available for schooling until 7:00 am on day of show.

Ribbons: Ribbons first through sixth place.

Championships: Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded for the following divisions: 2' Jmpr, Low Jmpr, Medium Jmpr, High Jmpr, Level 2 Jmpr, Level 3 Jmpr, Stirrup Htr, Pre Child/Ad, Child/Ad, Junior/Ad, Schooling Htr, Open Htr, Future Eq., Crossrails, Walk/Trot, Adaptive Rider

Points 1st-6th as follows: 10, 6, 4, 2, 1, .5

Food: concessions may not be available on premise. Pack accordingly

Dogs: All dogs must be on a leash attached to a person

Non-negotiable checks: If your check is returned for any reason, a penalty of \$35 will be assessed. Exhibitors have 10 days after notification to make full payment plus penalty in certified funds, cashier's check or money order.

Adds/Scratches: There is no fee for adds or scratches during the show day, but an add/scratch slip must be filled out.

Refunds: Full refund of all prepaid fees if entry is scratched prior to closing date. After the closing date, the prepaid amount minus the \$25 office fee will be refunded at the end of the show

Every entry at a competition shall constitute an agreement and affirmation that all participants (which include, without limitation, the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider, handler and the horse(s) themselves, their principals, representatives, employees and agents) (1) shall be subject to the constitution and rules of the associations and the local rules of the competition (2) represent that every horse, rider, driver, handler is eligible as entered (3) agree to be bound by the rules of the competition and will accept as the final decision of the horse show on any question arising under said rules and agrees to hold the competition, their officials, directors, and employees harmless for any action taken (4) agree that as a condition of entry they authorize the competition management to market, transfer, assign or otherwise make use of any photographs, likenesses, films, broadcasts, cablecasts, audiotapes, taken of the horse(s) and participants(s) while on the grounds, incident to or in transit between the stabling facility and the event site, in anyway they see fit for the promotion, coverage, or benefit of the event, without compensation to any of them, so long as the use neither jeopardizes amateur status nor endorses a specific product or service, and hereby expressly and irrevocably waive and release any rights in connection with such use, including any claims to invasion of privacy, right of publicity or to misappropriation, and (5) agree that they participate voluntarily in the competition fully aware that horse sports and the competition involve inherent dangerous risk of serious injury or death, and by participating they expressly assume any and all risk of death, and by participating they agree to indemnify and hold the competition and their officials, directors, employees, and agents harmless from and against all claims including for any injury or loss suffered during or in connection with competition, whether or not such claim, injury or loss resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligent acts

I agree that Freedom Run Stables, Jen Baltrus, the owners of the facilities, their officials and employees will not be held responsible for any accident or loss which may occur to an exhibitor, spectator, guest, rider, groom, attendant or other employee, animal or equipment at the show(s) listed in this prize list. I further agree to repay Freedom Run Stables and the owners of the facility, on demand all damages it may sustain by reason of any claim or demand. In the event, hereby entry or entries are made for or on behalf of an exhibitor under the age of 21 years, that I am one of the parents of such minor, or duly appointed legal guardian of such minor, and as such, entitled to make this entry for an on behalf of such minor, and I further hereby represent and agree that in the event made on behalf of another person, I have full authority and privilege from such person to make such entry for an on behalf of such other person.
